

COMPREHENSIVE SANITARY SEWER STUDY OF THE NORTHEAST BRANCH SEWER BASIN

The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) is conducting a comprehensive sanitary sewer study to highlight potential sewer problems in an effort to avoid costly major sewer repairs and support the WSSC's efforts to protect the environment and public health.

Manhole inspections will take place from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday in the town, beginning February 28, 2011 and ending May of this year.

The crews will use barricades to block off manholes where the inspection is taking place; however, the barricades will not disrupt neighborhood traffic. The studies are quiet, so noise will be at a minimum.
