### **TOWN ALERT 4: COVID-19**

This Alert supplements and amends the Town Alert 3: COVID-19 issued on Monday, March 23, 2020. All conditions of previous Alerts remain except as outlined below:

Department specific changes:

- All previous changes continue. No additional changes at this time.

The following closures, cancellations and/or suspension of services are until further notice and were not listed in the previous Town Alert:

- Mayor and Council Work Session scheduled for March 30, 2020 has been cancelled. Please monitor the Town's website, and social media platforms for information regarding upcoming meetings.
- Centennial Celebration – all events are postponed. The Town has been working with a group of volunteers to plan events commemorating the 100<sup>th</sup> Year of the Town. A variety of smaller celebrations had been scheduled for April, May, and early June with the large celebration scheduled for June 13<sup>th</sup>. There are too many uncertainties to keep the current schedule. The Town will work with volunteers and plan to host a variety of events in the summer with the larger celebration in the early fall.
