Project Background and Overview

The purpose of the project is to provide a safe and reliable crossing for drivers, cyclists and pedestrians and enhance community connectivity. The bridge is a dualspan, concrete arch bridge constructed in 1931 that serves more than 5,500 vehicles and several hundred pedestrians per day. The bridge crosses the Northeast Branch of Anacostia River and provides east-west connectivity within the Town of Riverdale Park. While it is structurally safe for travel, the bridge is nearing the end of its useful service life and needs to be replaced. The proposed replacement bridge will include two 11-foot lanes, 5-foot shoulders, and sidewalks on both sides. Replacing the bridge will reduce maintenance costs and support the safety and mobility of motorists and pedestrians. Other improvements include:

- Constructing continuous sidewalks on both sides of the structure and approach roads for improved pedestrian travel
- Relocating underground and overhead utilities
- Constructing drainage and stormwater management facilities
- Installing high-visibility crosswalks

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
Project Background and Overview (Continued)

The existing bridge, part of MDOT SHA's Historic Highway Bridge Program, was built in 1931 and is one of four concrete arch bridges in Prince George's and Montgomery counties. Because of its age, the bridge is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. MDOT SHA is seeking input from the Maryland Historical Trust, Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and local residents regarding the removal of the bridge as required by the state and federal historic preservation laws, including the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended.


What to Expect During Construction

Several utility relocations must be completed before the new bridge can be constructed. Tentatively, utility relocation work is scheduled to begin as early as spring 2023. Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2024 at which time traffic will be detoured to the adjacent MD 410 bridge. The detour, necessary for the safety of work crews and the traveling public, will remain in effect for approximately six months, weather permitting. The full road closure will allow crews to safely replace the bridge in a shorter period of time.

Crews will construct a temporary pedestrian bridge to the south, connecting to the Northeast Branch Trail and Tanglewood Drive. The trail crossing will remain open.



New Riverdale Road Bridge - Typical Section






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Other Alternatives Considered

The existing two-span arch bridge cannot be removed in stages because of its inherent design characteristics. An option to construct a new bridge on a parallel alignment was considered. This would avoid the need for a detour, but it would involve impacting several acres of the Anacostia River Stream Valley Park. It was decided that a full closure would provide the maximum benefit to worker safety, speed of construction, and environmental stewardship.
