Bike directions to the Center for Educational Partnership, home of the Renaissance Youth Bike Shop, the Master Peace Community Farm, and the Engaged University

From the University of Maryland / College Park Metro Station

Ride down River Road away from the metro station, make a right on Kenilworth Avenue, a left on Quintana Street, a left on Roanoke Avenue, and a left on 62nd Place. Go one block and it is on the left.

From Greenbelt and the North

The most scenic (and safest!) way is to take the Indian Creek Bike Trail to the Northeast Branch Trail at Lake Artemesia. Take the Northeast Branch Trail south past East-West Highway to Riverdale Road. Get off the trail and make a left on the road, going east. Follow directions below.

A faster way that uses more busy roads is to simply ride south on Kenilworth Avenue, make a left on Quintana Street, a left on Roanoke Avenue, and a left on 62nd place. Go one block and it is on the left.

From the District and the South

From Dupont Circle, Columbia Heights, and Brookland, get on Monroe Street NE going away from Catholic University. Take that to Rhode Island Avenue, and make a left. Ride through Mt. Rainier, and make a right at Charles Armentrout Drive. At the end of Armentrout, you can get on the Northeast Branch Trail. From the road, make a left on the trail so the river is on your right. Take that to Riverdale Road, get off the trail and make a right on the road, going east. Follow directions below.

From Chevery, the Bladensburg Waterfront Park, and the South

Take Bladensburg Road north to the intersection of Alt. Rt. 1 and 202 (the "Peace Cross"), and get on Alt. Rt. 1. Go a short distance, on the far end of the bridge is a bike path heading from the road to the river. Go down the path to the Northeast Branch Trail, and head north, so the river is on your right. Take that to Riverdale Road, get off the trail and make a right on the road, going east. Follow directions below.

From the Northeast Branch Trail and Riverdale Road

Ride on Riverdale Road east, immediately crossing the river. Cross through Kenilworth Avenue, and then immediately across Rt. 410. Both are busy roads, please cross with care. Once through Rt. 410, you will be on Roanoke Ave. Take that through the neighborhood, and make a left on 62nd Place. Make a left, we are one block on the right.
