



Major weekend track work planned for the weekend of February 27-March 1

Buses replace trains between Greenbelt and College Park on the Green Line; Single tracking on Red, Orange, Blue and Yellow Lines

Reconstruction of the Metrorail system will continue over the weekend of February 27-March 1 with service adjustments beginning at 10 p.m. Friday night and continuing through system closing on Sunday. (Note: The Green Line shutdown will begin at 12:01 a.m. Saturday.)

Weekend highlights include:

- Buses will replace Green Line trains between Greenbelt and College Park at 12:01 a.m. Saturday until Sunday closing.
- Red Line trains will operate every 8-15 minutes.
- Blue Line trains will operate every 20 minutes.
- Orange Line trains will operate every 20 minutes.
- Yellow Line will operate every 20 minutes between Huntington and Mt Vernon Sq only.
- Silver Line will run regular weekend service.

Metro is investing \$5.5 billion to install new rail, ties, platforms, escalators, signals, lighting, communication systems, and more. It represents the largest capital investment -- and work effort -- since the system's original construction in the early 1970s.



Green Line

Buses replace trains at Greenbelt Station from 12:01 a.m. Saturday until Sunday closing

From 12:01 a.m. Saturday through closing Sunday, free shuttle buses will replace Green Line trains between Greenbelt and College Park. Riders using shuttle bus service should allow 15 minutes additional travel time.

Green Line trains will operate at normal weekend intervals between College Park and Branch Ave.

Station Closed: Greenbelt

Work Performed: Continued construction of a new test track located between College Park and Greenbelt to accept Metro's new fleet of 7000-series railcars.

Travel Tip: Riders who normally use Greenbelt Station may wish to consider College Park as an alternate this weekend.





Red Line

Single tracking between Medical Center & Friendship Heights; Trains every 8-15 minutes

Red Line trains will operate as follows throughout the weekend:

- Between Shady Grove & Glenmont: every 15 minutes
- Between Friendship Heights & Silver Spring: every 8-10 minutes Saturday and Sunday from 9AM-9PM only

Work Performed: Joint elimination, track fastener and insulator renewal for a safer ride will cause Red Line trains to share one track between Medical Center and Friendship Heights.



Blue Line

Single tracking between Pentagon City & National Airport; Trains every 20 minutes

Blue Line trains will operate every 20 minutes throughout the weekend

Work Performed: Rail renewal for a safer ride will cause Blue Line trains to share one track between Reagan National Airport and Pentagon stations.



Orange Line

Single tracking between Stadium-Armory & Cheverly; Trains every 20 minutes

Orange Line trains will operate every 20 minutes throughout the weekend.

Work Performed: Platform rehabilitation will cause Orange Line trains to share one track between Stadium-Armory and Cheverly.



Yellow Line

Single tracking between Pentagon City & National Airport; Trains every 20 minutes

Yellow Line trains will operate every 20 minutes throughout the weekend.

All trains will operate to/from Mt. Vernon Sq, rather than Fort Totten. If you are traveling to or from a station north of Mt. Vernon Sq, use a Green Line train to complete your trip.

Work Performed: Rail renewal for a safer ride will cause Yellow Line trains to share one track between Reagan National Airport and Pentagon stations.
